This course provides your nominated first aiders with the confidence and competence to fulfil their duties in highly stressful environments. ## WHO IS IT FOR?

This course is designed for security guards, event marshals, public facing staff and those who work in high-risk environments. It is especially suited to nominated first aiders who would be the first responder on scene to a major emergency incident.

- Bleeding
- Dealing with catastrophic bleeding
- Use of tourniquets, trauma dressings, and haemostatic agents
- Making improvised medical equipment
- Severe burns and fractures
- Major wounds (gun shot, blast injuries)
- Shock and recognising post traumatic stress
- Unresponsive casualties
- Major illnesses, anaphylaxis and seizures
